





ELIGIBILITY



Progression to Sec 5NA

i. Promotion Criteria from Sec 4N(A) to Sec 5N(A)

2 Sec 4N(A) students can be promoted to Sec 5N(A) if they satisfy <u>all</u> the following criteria:

- (a) Sat for the GCE N(A)-Level Examination in 2023;
- (b) Obtained an ELMAB3 aggregate score of 19 points or less; and
- (c) Obtained at least an N(A)-Level Grade 5¹ for all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3; and
- (d) Will not be more than:

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- i) 4 years overage, for Singapore Citizens (SC)/ Permanent Residents (PR) (i.e. should be born on or after 2 Jan 2003), or
- ii) 2 years overage, for International Students (IS) (i.e. should be born on or after 2 Jan 2005).

Progression to DPP [JIE 'H"]

6 In lieu of progressing to Sec 5N(A), Sec 4N(A) students may consider enrolling into two-year *Higher Nitec* courses at ITE through the DPP. DPP students who successfully complete their *Higher Nitec* courses and attain the minimum qualifying Grade Point Average (GPA) are subsequently guaranteed a place in a polytechnic diploma course mapped to their *Higher Nitec* course.

- 7 Sec 4N(A) students may apply for the DPP if they satisfy <u>all</u> the following criteria:
 - (a) Sat for their GCE N(A)-Level Examination in 2023 as school candidates;
 - (b) Obtained a raw ELMAB3 aggregate score of 19 points or less³ (excluding CCA bonus points); and
 - (c) Met subject-specific entry requirements for each course, as stated in https://www.ite.edu.sg/admissions/full-time-courses/higher-nitec-dpp.

8 Following the release of the GCE N(A)-Level results in December 2023, DPP-eligible students may submit an application online via the ITE website (<u>https://www.ite.edu.sg</u>). Successful applicants will be required to attend a 10-week preparatory course prior to commencing their *Higher Nitec* courses. More information can be found at <u>https://www.ite.edu.sg/admissions/full-time-courses/higher-nitec-dpp</u>.

Progression to PFP

- 10 Sec 4N(A) students may apply for the PFP if they satisfy <u>all</u> the following criteria:
 - (a) Sat for their GCE N(A)-Level Examination in 2023 as school candidates;
 - (b) Obtained a raw ELMAB3 aggregate score of 12 points or less⁴ (excluding CCA bonus points); and
 - (c) Met the subject-specific entry requirements stated in <u>https://pfp.polytechnic.edu.sg/PFP/pfp_eligibility.html</u>.
 - Sec 4N(A) students have the following options in applying for the PFP and DPP:
 - (a) <u>Students who are only interested in applying for the PFP</u> should first progress to Sec 5N(A), even if they meet the PFP eligibility criteria based on their GCE N(A)-Level results in December 2023. They may then apply for the PFP upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2024. If their application is successful, they will withdraw from Sec 5N(A) by the end of January 2024⁵. All PFP-bound students are required to attend Sec 5N(A) classes in their secondary schools up till the last Friday of January 2024, i.e. 26 January 2024.

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Retention of Sec 4 (NA) students

14 Sec 4N(A) students are eligible to repeat their GCE N(A)-Level Examination as school candidates if they satisfy <u>all</u> the following criteria:


(a) Obtained an aggregate score:

- i) Not exceeding 21 points for ELMAB3 (i.e. ELMAB3 ≤ 21), or
- ii) Not exceeding 14 points for ELB3 (English Language and best three other subjects, which can include Mathematics) (i.e. **ELB3** ≤ **14**), or
- iii) Not exceeding 14 points for MAB3 (Mathematics and best three other subjects, which can include English Language) (i.e. **MAB3** ≤ **14**); and


(b) Will not be more than:

- i) 4 years overage, for SC/PR (i.e. should be born on or after 2 Jan 2004), or
- ii) 2 years overage, for IS (i.e. should be born on or after 2 Jan 2006)⁷; and
- (c) Sat for the GCE N(A)-Level Examination for the first time in 2023.



JIE 'N'/JIE 'E' – Joint Intake Exercise


The JIE 'N' is for 2-year *Nitec* or 3-year *Higher Nitec* courses offered by ITE.

PFP is a one-year programme that offers a practice-oriented curriculum taught by polytechnic lecturers to better prepare polytechnic-bound Secondary 4 N(A) students for entry into selected polytechnic diploma courses. PFP students are given provisional places in diploma programmes, subject to them passing all modules in the one-year programme.




