## Data Backup Instructions – 10 November Monday and DMA Uninstallation – 13 November Thursday.

13 To ensure a smooth DMA uninstallation, your child/ward should back up all important data from his/her PLD. Data can be saved to an external storage device or a cloud storage service.

14 There is no need to come to school for the DMA uninstallation. Students can complete the DMA offboarding at home by following detailed instructions that will be sent to your child/ward's student iCon email on 10 November Monday. Kindly remind your child/ward to check his/her email.

15 The Device Management Application (DMA) will be uninstalled from your child/ward's Personal Learning Device (PLD) on 13 November Thursday. Once the offboarding exercise is completed, the device will no longer be subject to DMA monitoring. All browsing history stored on the DMA server will also be permanently deleted.

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16. Please note that all students must complete the DMA offboarding by **31 December 2025**. Students who do not do so will lose access to the data stored on their PLD.

17. For students who require support with the DMA offboarding, they may report to **Computer Lab 2** on the dates below. Please ensure your child/ward brings a **fully charged PLD**.
